



## 2019 OVPDEMA Study Abroad Program to India



**Program Sites:** Delhi, Agra, Varanasi, Mumbai

- Student in Groups, HHSP, 21<sup>st</sup> Century Scholars Program
- FASE mentor or OVPDEMA-funded ASC tutor
- At least 18 years old
- Have minimum IU CUM GPA of 2.7

### Course Description:

The purpose of the India Study Abroad Program is to provide an opportunity for students to gain in-depth and experiential knowledge of Indian history, social and cultural norms, social just and responsibility issues across India and urbanization and globalization in India. In general, students benefit from the program in the following areas: intellectual and academic growth, career enhancement, personal growth, development of cross-cultural skills, and acquisition of new perspectives on world affairs, and by receiving self-awareness of the culture in the US and in other countries. The course and trips are open to undergraduate IU Bloomington students in the Hudson and Holland Scholars Program (HHSP), Groups Scholars Program, IU Bloomington 21<sup>st</sup> Century Scholars Program or mentors of the Faculty and Staff for Student Excellence (FASE) Mentoring Program, and OVPDEMA-funded tutors of the Academic Support Center.

**Course Requirements:** Students must apply and be accepted. Students must have or obtain a valid passport. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due March 8, 2019 (applicable to the total course cost).

**Course Credit:** 3 credits (INST-I100)
